

**RESOLUTION
R267-10/11**

WHEREAS, pursuant to §11-54A-1 et al, the Selma Downtown Redevelopment Authority was established in 1994 for the purpose of the revitalization and redevelopment of the central business district of the City of Selma through projects that will promote the public good and general welfare trade, commerce, industry, employment opportunities and the general welfare of the City and the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, §11-54A-7 outlines the powers of the authority exercised by the Board. Further, the Board shall consist of any number of directors, not less than three, who shall be elected by the governing body of the city for staggered terms; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, upon the recommendation of the Mayor appointed the following members to the Board:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Code of Alabama, the directors must be appointed for staggered terms and shall be a duly qualified elector of the City of Selma; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Selma City Council to divide the members of the Board into three groups and specify for which term each director will serve.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, ALABAMA AS BY VIVA VOCE VOTE AS FOLLOWS:

That **John Calame, Forrest Hatfield, Ted Henry and Thomas Atchison** are hereby elected by the Selma City Council to serve as members of the Selma Downtown Redevelopment Authority for a term of *two years* retroactive to May 31, 2011 to May 31, 2013;

That **Juanda Maxwell, Nancy Sewell and Nancy Smith** are hereby elected by the Selma City Council to serve as members of the Selma Downtown Redevelopment Authority for a term of *four years* retroactive to May 31, 2011 to May 31, 2015;

That **Harold Speir, Johnny Moss, Jr., Clint Wilkinson and Lee Calame** are hereby elected by the Selma City Council to serve as members of the Selma Downtown Redevelopment Authority for a term of *six years* retroactive to May 31, 2011 to May 31, 2017.


