Water Avenue Resurfacing and Brick Paving Contract Award

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma published an advertisement for bids in the Selma Times Journal to receive bids for the Resurfacing and Brick Paving along Water Avenue from Franklin Street to Martin Luther King Street to MLK and for the brick paving of the entranceway to the new Riverfront Park at the Green Street entrance ; *and*

**WHEREAS**, sealed bids were received by the City of Selma at Selma City Hall, 222 Broad Street, Selma from the time solicited and closed at 10:00 am on October 21, 2011, at which time the bids received were opened and read aloud; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the appropriate officials of the City and the project engineer, Hogg Engineering, tabulated the bids and determined Asphalt Contractors to be the lowest responsible bidder, said bids are certified by Hogg Engineering; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to award Asphalt Contractors a in the amount of \$175,895.00 for the Resurfacing and Brick Paving along Water Avenue; *and*

**WHEREAS**, it is desired that said contract expenses be encumbered via the Municipal Gas Tax account.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a contract amount in the amount of \$175,895.00 for the Resurfacing and Brick Paving along Water Avenue.


